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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

THE EXCELSIOR DISTRICT IMPROVEMENT ASSOCIATION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

THAT We, the undersigned, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a non-profit corporation under and pursuant to the laws of the State of California; and we do hereby certify:

ARTICLE I

That the name of said corporation is THE EXCELSIOR DISTRICT IMPROVEMENT ASSOCIATION.

ARTICLE II

That the purposes for which said corporation is formed are as follows: The purpose of this Association shall be to promote civic improvement and the general welfare of our district and City of San Francisco.

ARTICLE III

That it is a corporation which does not contemplate the distribution of gains, profits, or dividends to the members thereof.

ARTICLE IV

That this corporation is organized pursuant to part 1 of Division 2 of Title 1 of the Corporation's Code.

ARTICLE V

That the County in this State where the principal place and office for the transaction of business of this corporation is San Francisco County.

ARTICLE VI

The names and addresses of the persons who are to act in the capacity of directors until the selection of their successors

7 directors of the corporation until changed by an amendment to the
8 Articles, or unless the articles otherwise provide by a By-Law adopted
9 by the members.


10 ARTICLE VII

13 method of voting, and other rights and privileges of each class of
14 membership, and the liability of each or all classes for dues, and

17 cate of membership which shall not be assignable or transferrable.

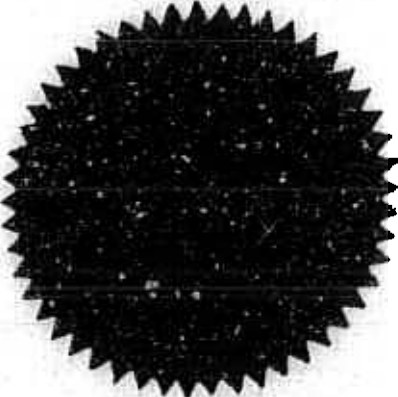

Re: Exemption from Franchise Tax

Gentlemen:

It is the opinion of this office, based upon the evidence presented, that you are exempt from State Franchise Tax under the provisions of Section 23701^f of the Revenue and Taxation Code, as it is shown that you are organized and operated exclusively as a civic league.

Accordingly, you will not be required to file franchise tax returns unless you change the character of your organization, the purposes for which you were organized, or your method of operation. You are required to report any such changes immediately to this office in order that their effect upon your exempt status may be determined.

If in any year your gross income exceeds \$25,000, you are required to file an information return on Form 199 on or before the 15th day of the 5th month following the close of your fiscal year. These forms will be mailed to you if you provide us with your current postal address.

If the organization is not yet incorporated or has not yet qualified to do business in California, this approval will expire unless incorporation or qualification is completed within thirty days.
