Police report by Captain Louis Cassanego: a recent sexual assault in Crocker Amazon was reported (April 1) and an arrest was made a few days later. Several fires happened, one on at 3214 Mission and one inside McLaren Park. Most all categories reported downward trends.

Treasurer's Report: \$2,533.82 in account.

Discussion on D11 Budget Town Hall; many felt the meeting too 'scripted' and that individual residents were not heard as open questions were cancelled. Motion made and passed to send letter to Mayor Lee expressing disappointment and to remind him of his promise to revisit the Excelsior. (12-0)

Parking Committee update: residents on Edinburgh presented petition to NOT have parking changed; Madrid to be pilot program for 90 days after which time, EDIA will hold a summit to review the pilot and the changes MTA will be making off Persia/Paris after the 90 days.
